- **Notes on the club draw tournament:**

CRB tournaments are team tournaments where boaters draw non-boaters for each event with the following draw exceptions:

Family Members. The CRB promotes family participation.

We encourage family members to fish together, if they would like.
Father/child and husband/wife.

Guests. Guests are permitted for only 3 tournaments annually, provided all non-boater members have a boater. It is our goal to have our club members the opportunity to fish, before we bring guest into the club. Please contact the club officers in advance of meeting if you plan to fish with a guest.

Boaters: Enter the draw as a boater if you can be your draw's guide for the day. Reliability of your equipment and knowledge of the water helps your partner have a good day fishing. New members considering the draw as a boater, please contact club officers before meeting.

Non-Boaters: Agree to share in fuel expense with your boater. Discuss a plan and understand in advance fuel costs on the water and towing to the ramp. Bring to the event: Approved personal floatation device, Rain Gear, Food and Drink, Eye Protection, Warm Clothing, and prepared fishing tackle. Make your boater's day a good day on the water.
