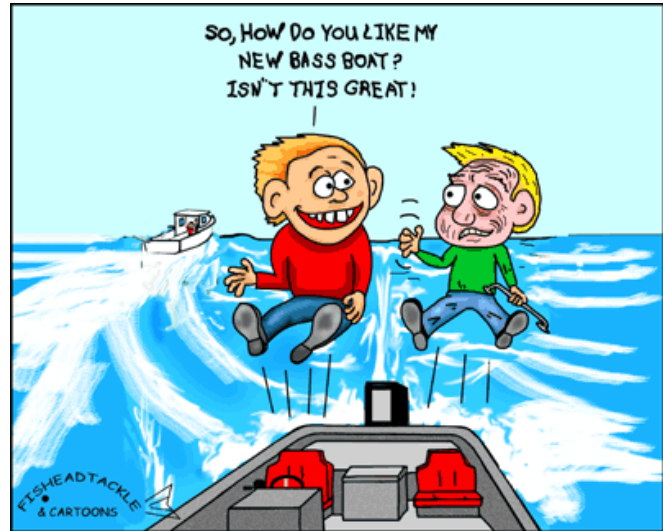

1st Place: Jerry Lee & Jevon Jackson - 14 lb 10 oz

First I would like to say Thanks for all of the support at the last tournament with my first win with the club. Everyone is awesome !! I had the chance to fish with one of our new members Jevon . This was Jevon 's first time being on the river and fishing for smallies. I had the chance to prefish the day before and seen the water level had dropped tremendous from our last tournament and knew I was going to need to change plans . With the wind blowing the morning of the tournament I made the decision to stay close to the ramp and fish the majority of the day . We had our limit by 8:00 am and continued to catch fish throughout the day . All of the fish we weighed in were caught on a watermelon hula grub and a 4" swing impact Kietech swimbaits . Looking forward to our next derby at Stevenson .

2nd Place: Gary Harral & Terry McCoy - 11 lb 02 oz

Things started out very slow for us on Saturday catching many small fish but caught our first keeper at 9 AM along an upriver Oregon side rip rap bank where we completed a very small limit in the 5.5 pound range by 10 AM. We made a move up river to one of my favorite spots and culled four of our five fish including two in the 2.5 pound range. We wanted to head back no later than 2 PM so we crossed to the Washington side tried a similar spot where I caught the 3-10 we weighed culling a 1-06. We caught fish many ways including swim baits and crank baits however four of our five weigh in fish were caught on green pumpkin black flake single tail grubs on a 3/16 or 1/4 ounce ball head. One of our 2-08 fish was caught on a shaky head worm.

3rd Place: Bob Judkins & David Lenihan - 09 lb 01 oz

I was surprised at the water level. Three to four feet lower than the last time we fished here. We went east. First spot a spawning cove . No fish . Back out on the main river . Fishing current breaks and back eddies. Didn't fish to far east the wind made for a ruff ride. Best fish came on drop shot 4" watermelon seed nose hooked trick stick. Dry Creek 2 1/2" Stubbie Snake River Craw tube , Keiteck Easy shiner silver flash minnow 1/4oz Darter Jig Head. Did not have a kicker fish .Maybe next time.
