1st Place: Renaud Pelletier & Jessie Jans - 15 lb 00 oz

I found two areas in previous trips that had good current flowing over extended gravel bar points. Both areas were holding numbers of fish. Small swimbaits and tubes were effective, but the larger bites came on a 1/2 oz Carolina rigged green pumpkin Zoom Super Hog. In the low water conditions of summer, finding good current areas is key in locating numbers of fish. The fish were five to twenty feet deep on the upstream side of the bars. We caught about twenty five or more keepers that day.

2nd Place: Bob Judkins & Terry McCoy - 14 lb 02 oz

We went east to my farthest spot first. Because of the wind. Working our way back fishing weed flats, bluffs, rock piles and deep rip rap . Limit by 8:30. Big fish came on drop shot 5" white Senko nose hooked. Next two on a white spinnerbait double willow blades. The rest on swimbait Keiteck Easy Shiner 4" and split tail grubs. 35 fish were caught.

3rd Place: Gary Harral & Jevon Jackson - 13lb 08 oz

Jevon and I started fishing downriver of the ramp but after 4 plus hours had only managed a small limit which included one 2.5 lb fish. Most everything was caught on grubs and other plastics but our best limit by 10:30 was only about 7 pounds. Since we saw a break in the wind we decided to run upriver but as we got up to the mouth of wind river it was starting to get pretty rough so I decided to not head up any farther since it appeared that the winds would only increase. We hit some Oregon side spots catching fish but only had one small cull after about an hour. I headed down river and pulled up onto a bank to do some cranking and swim bait fishing. We caught a couple and made a couple of small culls so I decided to expand the stretch of rip rap we were fishing. We were also fishing single tail grubs. I was only catching small fish on my DT16 so I decided to drag uses my swim bait and drag it towards the boat. Got lucky and put the 4-01 in the boat followed by a 3-10 a few minutes later both on the same 3.8" 1/4 oz head swim bait that I was crawling on the bottom towards the boat. With an hour to go in the day, we ran back towards the ramp to finish the day but didn't catch anything to increase our 13.5 lb bag. We had to weigh in a 1-12 that we just could not cull. We probably caught 40 fish on the day of which at least 25 were keepers but most were under 1-12.

1st Place: Mike Ieletzky & Terry McCoy - 10 lb 01 oz

At blastoff, Mike and I fished the east bank by the launch for an hour or so with not even a bite. We headed north cutting across a shallow spot. At the end of the island Mike panicked when his graph showed 2ft of water and turned off his motor coasting across the shallow end of the island. I said lets fish here. I casted my brown magic worm on a split shot rig landing in the shallow and then dragging it to 20 ft of water. All the sudden hooked up with our 1st keeper. 5 minutes later Mike and I had a double, now we have 3 keepers. Mike was hooking up some nice fish on ned rigs. Then it turned very windy with no bite for 2 hours. With an hour to weigh in I casted my 8 lb. test split shot brown worm rig in the wind landing in 2 ft of water catching the 2lb 9oz smallmouth. At that time we were doing a fish doodle dance because we remembered at the launch Bob and his great knowledge of fishing predicted 10 lbs will win today. We fished shallow to 20' in the 100-yard stretch on the north side of the island all day.

2nd Place: Bob Judkins & Randy Mock - 9 lb 14 oz

Fished within sight of the ramp. Limit by 7:45 .culling slowly, 19 fish for us. For me drop shot. Dry Creek tubes 2 1/2 inch stubbie snake river craw and white mad river steelhead worms, for Randy 3 inch grub,smoke w/red flakes & speed craw green pumpkin.
