Team Decker wins Silver Lake with 21.43lbs

Silver Lake May 22nd Six teams had to accept that a week of cool rainy weather was going to continue for the day on this shallow natural lake located in southwest Washington. Silver has a big fish reputation and while members had caught a few this spring, the lake temperature had dropped over ten degrees during the week prior to the event. Challenging conditions for Zip and Tristan Decker to make their debut on this lake. It fishes like Clearlake Rich Lockhart tells Zip. At the ramp Don Abbott has a map showing the hazards. He confirms there's docks around an island.

A canal behind the island reminded Zip of a channel he fished in the The Delta. He and Tristan flipped jigs to boat houses and docks and didn't pass up a few sparse lilly pads by the bank. Within a few minutes they spooked a fish off a bed and caught a 4lb really shallow. These would be their last shallow fish and they moved out and began targeting areas away from the bank. They pitched jigs to the outside of rock wing dams and Zip put another bass over 5lbs in the well. Teams were seen moving around the lake trying to locate the bigger fish. Meanwhile Team Decker continued pitching jigs and they filled their limit with more staging fish.

Finally, looking at a more open stretch Zip got out a cranking stick to cover water in the pre-spawn depth they were working. In about ten casts with a Rapala DT-10 Zip gets a big strike and holds his breath. The cranking outfit is loaded with 8lb test. Zip was lucky- she wasn't in much of a mood to fight, and she was led to the net just as Casey Capps and Rob Allen were driving over to see. She tipped the scales at 8.17lbs and Casey took her back to her spot after she was weighed. Team Decker had a banner day with 21.43lbs. With some pre-spawners of their own, 2nd place went to Casey Capps and Rob Allen with a limit of 10.89.
