Willamette River Swan Island

The Columbia River Bassmasters found themselves on water on the river that they, for the most part, had never seen. The water level on the river was higher than most anglers had ever experienced at eight to ten feet above normal pool. This did not stop the top three anglers in our club from catching quality limits in this event. Gary Estes, not satisfied with just having a big fish from our last event, went out on the Willamette and took First Place with his partner, Joe Badolato, together they had a 13.11 limit. Joe managed to catch the biggest fish in the event at 3.39 on a swim bait. Second Place finisher was Colby Botts fishing with his back-seater Shon Childers (CRB's 2010 AOY) and they had a couple of 3# bass in their limit. Third Place finisher Tom Hartshorn took his Ranger boat for a ride down the river with Rob Allen and brought back a 10.72 five-fish limit. Rob stood at the scales hoping his 3# plus small-mouth would outdo Joe's, but it was not quite big enough to outdo the 3.39. There were three "blanks" in this event one of which was your newsletter editors fishing on what he called his home water. The bass did not care! However, I can assure you that the three who did not bring a keeper to the scales did care! With the limited five years that I've had on the Willamette since moving here from Redding, California, not catching one keeper was really devastating to me. Especially when my partner Joe Doyle sticks a 3.33# bass and we loose it at the net in our first hour of fishing. Then he sticks a 15# Salmon that we net.
