*** CRB Tournament of Champions Oct 23rd ***

Smith and Chin to win Cascade Locks 9-18-10. 8 bites were enough!

Who could argue with mild and cloudy conditions for this much anticipated tournament on Cascade Locks? Maybe some of the members that recently experienced several late summer days on fantastic reaction fishing there. Would a few days of intermittent rain shut them down? Of the 8 teams that participated, 4 boats formed up line abreast and plied the glass smooth surface trimmed up and flat out. An exhilarating run though the magnificent cloud shrouded bluffs of the Columbia River Gorge.

Two teams peeled off at Wind Mountain. Tim Ihle and Mark Forbes later admitted the reaction fishing had tapered off, but not before Tim observed three big smallmouth rising up to inspect his Zara Spook. Tim gave the bait one twitch and BAM! the big fish of the trio crushes the bait. A real beast- it was the tournament's big fish- 4.51lbs. Three more nice fish and a keeper gave them the leading weight with 16.4lbs. Then the team of Chuck Smith and Ed Chin came to the scales. They claimed to get just eight bites all day, but judging by the bulging bag, the best five were going to be enough. They dropshot most of the day topping all competition with an amazing limit of five big specimens. Together they weighed 17.19lbs. Congratulations to Chuck Smith, his first CRB tournament victory.

Angler of the Year point leaders Zip Decker and Shon Childers finished 4th and 5th respectively, and Shon will take a seven point lead into the season's last event next month at Hood River. Stay tuned for the showdown between these two determined anglers the weekend of October 9th. Chip Grisham's backseat Alex is a freshman at Boise State and a new member of the Boise State Bass Fishing team. Substituting for Alex was Team Grish sponsor Todd Martinez, owner of Tualatin River Tackle. TR jigs produced 15lbs for their third place finish. Rain began during the run back to the launch, but it could not dampen the good times and smiles from all the anglers that participated.
